



- Research guide
  - SUBJECT: Identifying a topic
  - ISSUES: Developing the main things in issue
  - LEGAL: Identifying the potential legal issues
  - TITLE: Developing a title
  - STRUCTURE





- Think widely and creatively
  - News story
  - Case/Decision
  - Article (law or other)
  - Industry Reports
  - A trip to the movies ...
  - Tutorials are an opportunity to sound out ideas



## Case

- For example, Premier League litigation
  - C-403/08 Football Association Premier League, EU:C:2011:631
    - A football game is not a copyright work as "no creative freedom" as it is dictated by the "rules of the game". Is this right?
  - Directive (EU) 2019/790 on Copyright in Digital Single Market
    - Consideration but did not give copyright to "sport event organizers"
      - Do you agree?

### Article

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Particular article

 E.g., "Ideological Effects of the Basic Cinematographic Apparatus", JL Baudry – potential implications for a critique of film copyright and audience today

#### Interdisciplinary sources

- Interpret the article through a legal lens

# ISSUES

- The artistic, social, practical, economic, business etc.
  - What is in contention?
  - What is the potential dispute?

## Legal and Critical Analysis

- And then from there, what are the potential legal issues?
- Potential areas to explore:
  - Any extra-legal strategies for protection (fandoms, merchandising, etc)
  - The application of film theory to the scope of the work for the purposes of protection



- Informative
  - Essay's purpose
- Can be straightforward or more creative
- No need to put all the information into the title
   Aim for concise and informative

## Structure

- Introduction
  - CONTEXT In other words, what motivated this question
    - A particular challenge being faced by the industry?
    - A particular dispute?
  - OUTLINE Outline briefly what you will be arguing and how
  - SCOPE A 3000 word essay is limited in scope so you may wish to outline aspects that will be beyond the scope of your discussion (but you show your awareness of them)
  - CONCLUSIONS Any possible conclusions or recommendations arising from your work
- Headings and sub-headings
  - Very important
  - Signpost your argument throughout
  - Ensures reader can identify easily the points and steps of your argument
  - Assists with achieving a clear and readable structure
- Conclusion
  - Don't just restate your argument
  - This section can be used to explain why your essay is significant and any future implications or areas for research arising from your essay



# This is a research essay

- Research is crucial
- References and authorities must be provided for arguments
- Engage with authorities (do not just describe and paraphrase)


– Do you agree with the argument?

Compare other approaches?
Potential wider significance? Etc

## Referencing

## Footnotes are essential

- Do not use in-text citation
- Footnotes will count towards the word count
- Bibliographies are optional but recommended
  - Make sure you have engaged with all the references in the bibliography
  - Bibliographies do not replace footnotes
  - Bibliographies do not count in the word limit

2. Footnotes provide additional information about a sentence and direct readers to outside sources, either to cite an idea or to suggest additional reading about a topic.

## **Quality Research**

Research sources

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
- Relying on SSRN is not quality research
  - You must consult and cite the published form (not the draft)
  - You must consult peer-reviewed research (published articles, books etc)
- Consult legal research and recent articles
  - Peer-reviewed scholarly articles (eg not blogs and law firm client briefings)
  - Westlaw; Hein Online; LexisNexis; JSTOR etc
  - Practitioner texts
  - Film policy and production texts
  - Industry reports (as primary sources)
- Case comments on cases are not the same as reading the cases
  - Check your sources, read the cases, engage with the primary source
  - You must always consult and cite from the source, not cite a quote from the case in a secondary source
- Do not cite other forms of quotes in secondary sources – go to the original and check
- Blogs and newspapers, reviews etc may be interesting as examples of the cultural and social context, but they are \*not\* legal authorities
- Film texts film as a critical tool
- Footnote all your references

# Examples of poor scholarship



- Merely paraphrasing or largely copying/repeating articles from elsewhere
- Merely providing a citation at the end of lengthy paraphrasing without actual engagement with the argument
- It is important to show your engagement with and understanding of the sources and bringing them together in an insightful analysis of the issues in your essay

# Examples of good scholarship



- Able to synthesise various arguments in relation to your topic and your particular research question
- Bringing several authorities together into a fresh analysis
- Able to engage with those arguments that disagree with you and explain why they are not applicable
