Guidelines for the Term Paper

Academic Year 2023-24

- You should handle a short outline of your term paper by November 10, 2023. It should include a description of the research question addressed, and should not be longer than 1 page. Please send your <u>outline</u> by the end of the day of 10.11.2023 by email at <u>martina.viarengo@graduateinstitute.ch</u> [One-to-one meetings to review the outline will take place in the week of November 13-17, 2023]
- Deadline for term paper: December 19, 2023

 Please send your term paper by 5pm of 19.12.2023 by email at martina.viarengo@graduateinstitute.ch
- The topic covered in the term paper has to be related to one of the subjects discussed in the course (other topics/themes should be discussed with the Professor)
- Individual work
- Methodology open, i.e. can be a literature review, an empirical analysis, a theoretical work. Both qualitative and quantitative approaches are welcome. When presenting the existing literature on the subject, it is important to have a critical point of view
- Maximum 8 pages, Times New Roman 11pt, line spacing 1pt, justified
- The term paper should have a maximum length of 8 pages. You should use Times New Roman 11pt, line spacing 1pt, justified. There is no limit on the number of words
- -The list of references / bibliography should be presented at the end of the paper (after the conclusion) and is not included in the page count of the paper (i.e., it does not count towards the 8 pages limit, and it can have any length)
- Tables / Figures if any have to be included in the Appendix. The Appendix should be included at the end of the paper, and is not included in the page count of the paper (i.e., it does not count towards the 8 pages limit, and it can have any length).
