Eligibility Criteria for a Part-Time Job

Australian criteria for part-time work:

- A valid student visa for Australia
- Enrollment in a full-time study program authorized by the Australian Government
- The university's minimal attendance standards and academic requirements are fulfilled
- Student has international student health insurance

Things To Remember When Exploring Part-Time Jobs In Australia

- A student's part-time work cannot begin prior to the official start of the school year. He/She could be able to come a few months or days early but is not eligible to start work.
- Students who are enrolled in courses that require casework on a regular basis are exempt from this category.
- The working hours remain 40 hours per two weeks for the students enrolled in a preparatory course. Students who start writing their thesis and those who are in a Ph.D. program or who engage in postgraduate research can put in as many hours as they like.

If you meet all of the conditions for study, you can obtain a post-study work permit in Australia.
